**6th international Sculpture Symposium Moritzburg, 18.08 – 08.09.2013**

## **Human Being – Dream and Demand**

The symposium will take place in a historical grown cultural area. The typical landscape of Moritzburg is representing a desire of harmony between mankind and nature in a very significant baroque way.

The modern formed nature, covered by traffic lines made of concrete, often creates the feeling that this harmony is gone and with it the spaces of dream and beauty

The dreams, visions and demands of the own "Me" shall be focused in an artistic reflection and shall find their expression by means of sculpture arts. Expected are concepts of sculptures which refer to up to date ecologic, ethic, economic and esthetic topics of human society.

The assembly of the sculptures within the baroque landscape will promote its preservation and formation. As a result of the Sculpture Symposiums there will arise a wide-ranging sculpture path across the Moritzburg forest.

### **Call for Proposals**

The Symposium is announced internationally. It is organized by the association "International Sculpture Symposium Moritzburg e.V.". You are invited to create with the provided materials a work dealing with the topic "Human Being – Dream and Demand". For your application please send us a documentation of your own work and a sketch with detailed information about your project and its relation to the announced topic. The sculptures are to be planed for outside assembly.

Artists experienced with sculpturing in stone and wood or with creating large sculptures with ceramic material or concrete are welcome.

### **Selection of Artists**

A jury decides which candidates will be admitted. The number of participants is limited to 10, among them 3 or 4 from Germany. If you will be selected or not will be decided referring to the quality of your earlier works. There is no limitation of the candidate's age.

### **Material**

The provided material is:

- raw blocks of sandstone and oaken trunks in different sizes
- concrete
- material for terracotta (Baking will take place in Bad Liebenwerda)
- oaken trunks

Other material for example colors, gypsum or construction timber is provided.

## **Working Conditions**

The participants receive 1800 EUR in two installments.

Participants coming from beyond Europe will get 400 EUR for travel costs.

Working material will be provided for free.

Accommodation, breakfast and lunch will be offered for free.

Manual tools and technical devices (trestles, lifting tools) will be provided in a limited amount.

→ **Angle grinder cannot be used because of the location of work.**

→ **And the time of using a chainsaw will be strictly limited.**

The work must be able to be realized during the period of the symposium.

There will be contracts concluded with the participants about the acceptance of the announced conditions of participation.

## **Ownership of the Sculptures**

The sculptures created during the symposium become property of the organizer. The final placement will be decided by the association and the local administration. The artists may give a proposal concerning the presentation of their sculpture.

The association is still working on an international park of sculptures in Moritzburg, a presentation of the symposium's art work in nature accessible for tourists.
