Announcement

8th International Sculpture Symposium Moritzburg, 12.08 – 03.09.2017

“Living Space – Cultural Landscape”

The symposium 2017 is about cultural landscape as a living space of mankind. Referring to this topic the works of the symposium shall emphasize some ecological, economical, social, ethical or aesthetical aspects in discussion with classical and temporary forms of expression in doing sculpture.

Artists experienced with sculpturing in sandstone, oak wood or concrete are welcome. The created works are to be placed in several surroundings of different character (village, cultural Landscape, forest graveyard) in or around Moritzburg.

Place of work

The symposium will take place at a public green space along the Dippelsdorf Lake within the community of Moritzburg, where a reconstruction of the “Red House”, known from some paintings of the modern artists group “Brücke”, is located.

Selection of Artists

A jury decides which candidates will be admitted. The number of participants is limited to eight, among them the participants from Europe or beyond shall be the majority. Admissions will refer to the criteria of quality of your earlier works and of your artistic-craftsmanship.

Working Conditions

- The participants receive 2000 EUR in two installments.
- Participants coming from beyond Europe will get 400 EUR for travel costs.
- Accommodation, breakfast and lunch will be offered for free.
- Working material (raw blocks of sandstone and oaken trunks in different sizes) will be provided for free. Also manual tools and technical devices (trestles, lifting tools, color) will be provided in a limited amount.
- The artists normally work with their own tools and machines. If necessary there are some tools and machines the artist can get from the symposium. Please contact us if such is indicated.
- The work must be planned to be realized during the period of the symposium. And it must be deposable outside.
- The created works will become property of the Moritzburg Bildhauersymposium Association.
- There will contracts be made between Bildhauersymposium and the participants about the acceptance of the announced conditions of participation.
